## **UIP Goals Update**

- LITERACY: Literacy data is looking great!!
  - Many students are coming OFF Read plans in primary grades
  - We are focusing on foundational skills at all grades
    - Especially primary both languages
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> grade Fluency in reading Lots of writing
  - $4^{th}$  and  $5^{th}$  grade Focused on reading/lots of writing
- MATH EAA Protocol (IMPACT Teaming) continued school wide process/protocol Focus on math intervention that includes more targeted interventions
- MENTAL HEALTH/BELONGING Continued work towards ensuring that students feel a sense of safety and belonging – Second Step/Circle work/Use of Restorative practices
- OPTIONS FOR GRADUATION Continued to expand our afterschool programming: PSD3 (Spelling Bee/Baile/Strings), Triunfo, Odyssey of the Mind, Strings program this semester, Running Club – offer Span Enrich in Jan
  - Maker Space/Technology grants are being written (Otter Cares)
  - Parent engagement: Literacy Night, Math/Science Night, Movie Night, Friendship Dance, Fiesta
- School wide focus on growth/achievement for students with disabilities
